This aim of this guide is to introduce Edinburgh Napier University's staff and students to the Apple Mac Workstation image.

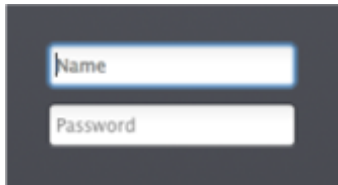

## Logging in:

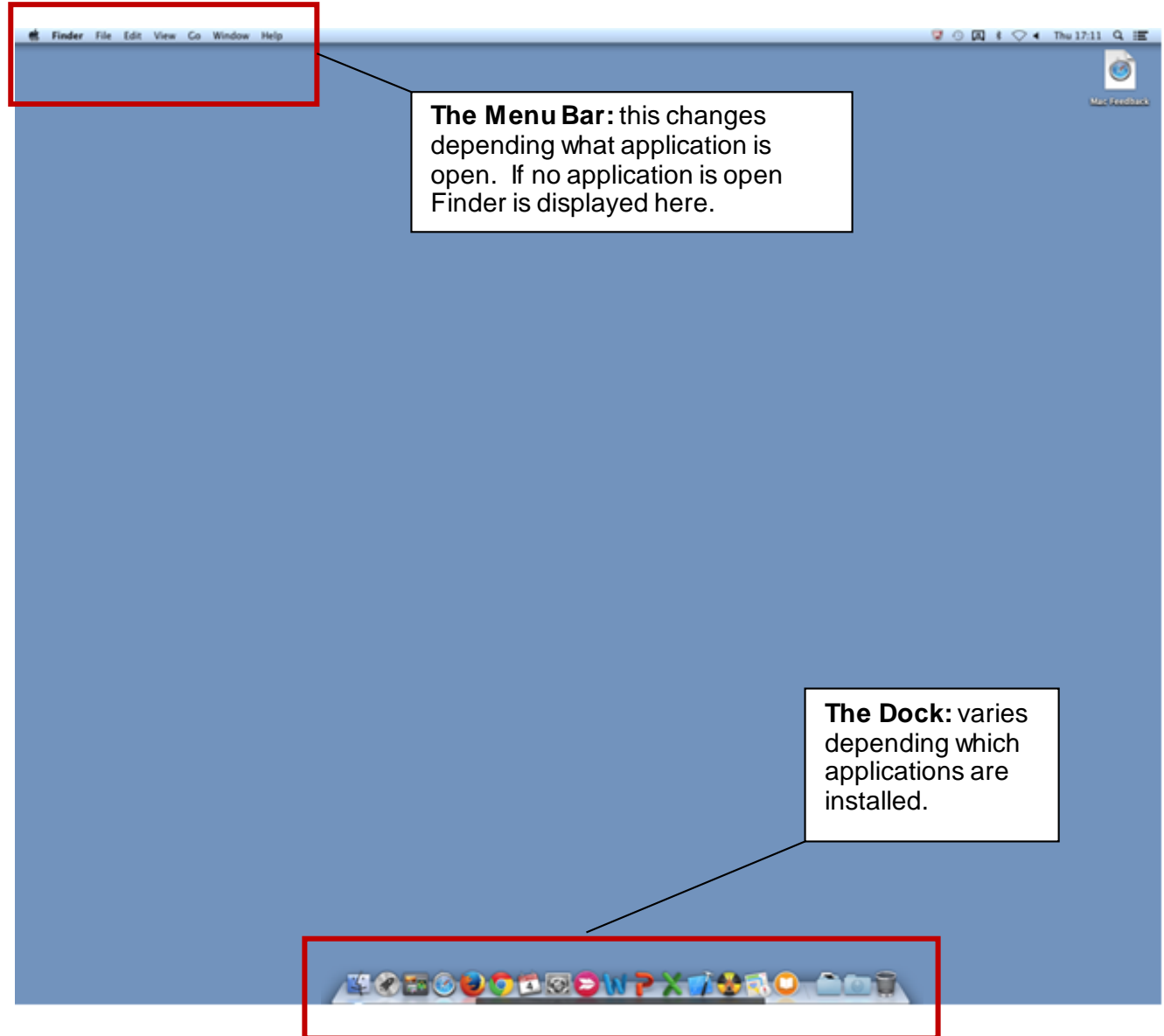
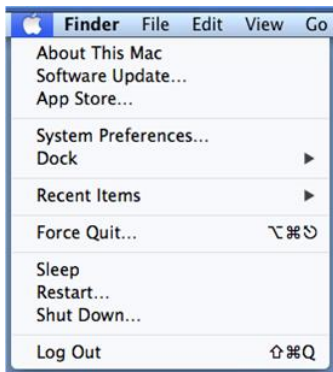
From the Apple Mac login screen enter your **University login ID (user name)** in the Name field, and enter your **University password** in the Password field:



Press the **Enter** key.

## Logging out:

The **Apple Menu** (found on the top left) is the equivalent to the Start menu on a PC. Use this to **log out** or **shut down** your machine:



**The Menu Bar:** this changes depending what application is open. If no application is open Finder is displayed here.

**The Dock:** varies depending which applications are installed.

**The Dock:** The appearance of the Dock varies depending which applications are installed but the key applications are described below:

**Finder:** all applications, documents and files can be found using the Finder (with the exception of your networked personal data area).

**Your Networked Personal Data Area:** use to access the files on your personal data area (H drive).



**Accessing your Applications:** Although there are a small set of applications accessible via the Dock, all applications can be found by clicking on the **Finder** icon and selecting **Applications** from the menu on the left. You can use the **Search** box to search for applications.

**Accessing your Files:** To access files from your University personal data area click on this icon:



To access all other files click on the **Finder** icon and select **All My Files** from the menu on the left. You can use the **Search** box to search your files.
